Submission

Initially via Canvas as 1 Word document (paste all of the metadata forms into 1 single, long Word document); final version will be uploaded to our website

Objective

We have spent a good deal of time looking at other peoples' digital humanities projects; now it's time to make our own. This assignment is a 3-dimensional exposure to the steps involved in making high quality humanities digital data, and sharing that data with the world: you'll create metadata through (1) archival research; (2) critical research; and then you will (3) use web editing to share that data with the world, and
